This session will cover the groundbreaking supply chain agreement, the Central Java Gender Justice Agreement, establishing a union-led program to prevent and eliminate workplace gender-based violence and harassment. The Agreement, signed among four unions, Korean multinational Ontide, and global labor organizations and complemented by a commitment from sportswear brand Fanatics, covers the 6,250 workers at Ontide's two factories in Indonesia. The agreement incorporates key definitions and elements from the ILO Convention 190 on Violence and Harassment.

The session will include interviews with women workers employed at the Ontide factories, union leaders, and a panel discussion with representatives of GLJ, AFWA, and the WRC.
